#### Square Meaters Cattle

The change of show date for 2011 saw a much better turn out of cattle with a total of 192 cattle entered compared to only 70 in 2010.

Cate & Graham Stanton of Naringi Square Meaters along with grandson Scott Davies Antill Square Meaters again flew the Square Meaters banner for the fourth year in a row.

Judge, Graeme Williams, renowned Shorthorn breeder from the Hawkesbury area was most impressed with the animals on display.

Naringi Diana F3 was the Junior Champion Square Meaters female going on to win the coveted Grand Champion Square Meaters exhibit. Mr Williams commented that the 14 month old heifer was “feminine while not fragile, had good depth and length and was a most impressive exhibit.” He suggested that she would be an interesting package to see next season with a calf at foot.
