

## **Square Meaters Success at Sydney Royal Show**

The Square Meaters breed has more than established its commercial credentials after an impressive performance at Australia's biggest purebred steer show.

Just 12 Square Meaters steers were among the more than 250 entries at the 2010 Sydney Royal Easter Show, but 10 of those animals walked away with a ribbon after the live judging.

Included in their haul were three class wins, two thirds and four fifth placings along with a highly commended .

A steer from Narrara Valley High School went on to win the reserve champion open middleweight steer of the show.

But that was only part of the triumph for Square Meaters.

In the carcass judging Square Meaters won a bronze medal in the middleweight open steer class, and scored two first placings and two second placings in the virtual taste test classes.

Three steers judiciously selected before the live judging by Deb Cotter and Kylie McKinnon then amassed enough points on the hook and hoof to earn the Square Meaters breed third place in the prestigious Stan Hill Trophy.

Those steers were two exhibited by the Narrara Valley High School and one by Murrumburrah High School

Congratulations to all the breeders and exhibitors for showing the rest of the beef industry that Square Meaters really are the compact quiet achievers when it comes to quality meat production
